Employment Supports	Through the Employment Access program, community employers partner with Cosmos to assist individuals to develop the necessary skills in order that they may become as independent as possible.
Community Options	Community Options offers individuals with disabilities an opportunity to increase social interaction and communication skills by participating in valued meaning activities outside of the home. Community Options is an alternative to employment or in addition to an existing employment situation
Volunteer & Community Support Services	Through this program, Cosmos assists individuals living with a mental illness or brain injury to become involved in their community through volunteering
