WHAT IT MEANS

The PDD Program will fund home living supports and services intended to assist individuals to live in a variety of settings in the community.

The PDD Program will fund supports that are consistent with the individual's assessed support needs, and that demonstrate they contribute to positive outcomes for individuals.

WHAT IT MEANS

The PDD Program will promote activities that stimulate the capacity of communities to share responsibility to support adults with developmental disabilities in their community.

This will include developing community leadership, partnering with others to encourage inclusive communities, and influencing change. Learnings from the activities will be shared provincially, across Community Boards, to promote best practices.
